Objective

Child Care

2002-2006 National professional temporary live-in nanny and baby nurse services for individual families

As a nanny I plan age-appropriate activities to promote physical, emotional and social development; plan, shop for and prepare nutritious meals and snacks; do the children's laundry; keep their bedrooms and bathrooms neat and tidy; change beds, pick up toys, run child-related errands and drive children to activities.

As baby nurse I nurture both baby and mother. General baby care includes bathing, diapering and dressing; feeding and assisting with breast feeding; preparation and clean up of formula and bottles; tending to medical monitors, oxygen and medicine; doing baby's laundry; and keeping nursery and play areas clean and tidy. I care for the mother by supporting and encouraging her while modeling child care and nurturing techniques that I adapt to her style.
